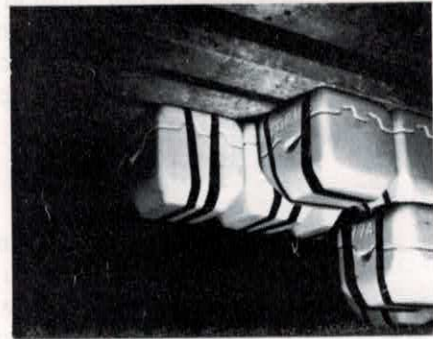
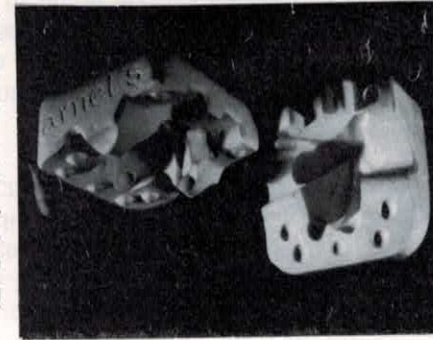
This is to acquaint you with one of the basic products of Hobby Ceramics. A ceramic mold, as used in the hobby business, should be regarded as a tool; and it should be given the care and respect afforded a fine tool of any trade or profession. The mold, being made of plaster, has certain characteristics that we will explain in the ensuing paragraphs so that you may get the most satisfying and long-lasting use from it.

First, we should know something about the ingredients of a mold — plaster and water. Plaster is made from Gypsum rock, which is found in deposits in scattered areas around the country. This rock is quarried, crushed, heated, and ground to its purest state. In the manufacture of molds, the plaster and water are mixed vigorously to produce a "slurry", which is poured around the previously-prepared object, or into a "block and case", (this being the name given to what might be called a "pattern" or a "die") to mass-produce the molds. Block-made molds give the finest quality and smoothness to your greenware.

Second, the care of the molds; — this is one of the most important factors in the life of a mold! Your molds should always be dry before using, and this must be done with care and takes a little time. The thing to bear in mind is that we are evaporating water. The warmer and drier the air, the faster the evaporation. It is imperative that you never subject the mold to heat in excess of 120 degrees for long periods of time, as the mold should always retain approximately 18% of its original water content. Permanent damage will occur in the form of checking and flaking if the water content is brought below this point by force-drying at too high a temperature. If molds must be force-dried, it is advisable not to subject them to forced heat for long periods of time; but when possible, let Nature take over and complete the job. There is one thing to remember: the sun will always do the best job of drying, if you have the time to wait.

Molds should be stored on shelves, in a light, dry, airy place, and be protected from mildew, as this will cause permanent damage and discoloration to the working surface of the mold. Molds are "friendly" things, and like each other! By this we mean that they will "share" their moisture — a dry mold will absorb moisture from a too-wet one. They also like to be used, but not abused!

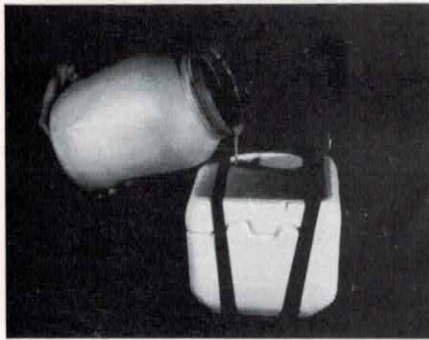
The way to tell a dry mold is by "feel". A wet mold has a "clammy" and cold feel, while a dry mold feels of room temperature. While a multiple-piece mold (two or more sections) is in the process of drying, it should be banded with rubber bands or tape, as plaster has a tendency to contour to whatever it is set on. By keeping it banded, it will prevent warping which results in an ill-fitting mold that will give wide, hard-to-clean seam lines on the greenware.

Sometimes the sections of a mold will stick together if it is tightly banded when newly made and has not been re-opened before completely dried. To insure no damage, it should be pried apart gently while the bands are still around the mold so that it will not "fly apart" when it loosens, breaking or chipping the edges. Then when it has been loosened, remove the bands and proceed to open it.



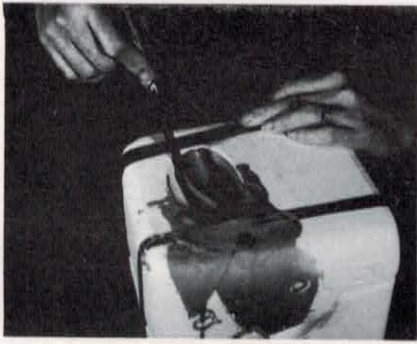
Third — the use of a mold. On every mold there is a "pouring hole" which may be of any shape, and in varying depths. Place the tightly-banded mold on a level surface, pouring-hole side up. Assuming that the mold is dry and ready for use, you may then pour the slip (liquid clay) into the pouring hole. Not too fast, nor too slow! Too fast may cause pinholes and poorly-filled detail in the greenware; and too slow will cause rings to appear on the greenware. Be sure to have within reach enough slip to fill the mold without stopping, because wherever you stop to get additional slip, a ring will appear which is difficult to remove from the greenware. The speed of pouring has to be governed by the size of mold, detail in mold, and thickness of the slip. Experience will soon tell you the proper pouring speed for each individual mold.



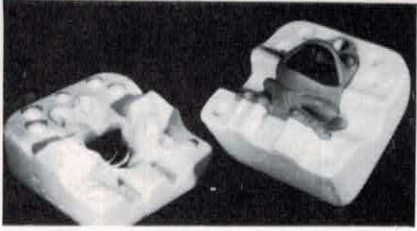
Fill the mold to the top of the pouring hole and keep it full until ready to empty. As the moisture is absorbed into the plaster, the level will go down, so add slip as often as necessary to keep it full. The mold is now doing its job of drawing the water from the slip and setting up a sidewall of clay next to the plaster, and will, of course, continue to do this until the casting (greenware) is removed from the mold. The length of time the slip is left in the mold will determine the thickness of the greenware. The thickness may be whatever you think would be best for a particular item or for a particular use, but the rule of thumb for Ceramic clay is one-eighth inch; and length of time is usually from ten to twenty minutes.



You now have the desired thickness, and it is time to drain out the excess slip. Care must be used in draining a mold, as this process must occur — air must replace the slip as it drains out! Some molds are designed with more than one pour-hole, and some have one large one, so this is no problem. However, some have small, single holes with a large amount of slip to drain out, and these need to be drained slowly. If "gurgling" occurs, you are draining too fast, and the mold should be tipped up to allow air to flow back into the mold. The action that takes place is this: as the slip runs out and no air replaces it, a vacuum occurs and the clay is drawn away from the mold and this will not set up and become firm; or it "sucks" away from the mold rapidly enough to cause the form to collapse. Assuming that you now have the slip all out, it is a good idea to tip the mold back and forth to be sure that no slip is still in a "low" place that will not drain. The mold should then be left to drip for a while until the casting is ready to take out. If the mold is an open-faced mold, such as a bowl, cup, plate, etc., it is a good idea to tip it slightly on an angle so the slip will drain clean and leave a nice surface on the inside portion of the cast.



The time required for the clay to set up sufficiently before removal from the mold will vary, but a good way to tell is when the clay begins to shrink away from the pouring hole.



Remove the bands; then each section of the mold in its turn may be taken off. The piece is now ready to be removed.



After removal, the greenware should be placed on something flat – preferably a level piece of plaster or plaster-board.



To prolong the life of your mold, cleaning it after use is important! Before putting it away, whether for over-night or for a longer period of time, remove any excess clay from the outside. This may be done with a soft cloth, sponge, or a plastic spatula **ON THE OUTSIDE**. Removing any clay from the bands, too, is a good idea, since once the clay has dried on the band it falls off easily, (usually into the mold after it has been made ready for pouring again, and you have to unband it, blow out the dried clay, and start over again if you want nice greenware!) The inside of the mold, especially on the surface which forms the greenware, should **NEVER** be cleaned with anything more harsh than a soft brush. An inch or inch-and-a-half wide brush, either camel hair or sable, is an ideal cleaning tool, and should be kept for that purpose only.

Now you are ready to put the sections of the mold back together, band it, and put it away; and you are on your way to enjoying the most pleasant and intriguing hobby available to you today!
